Accessible websites are those allowing easy access to their content for all types of users, including people with disabilities needing to use specialized software or hardware.

For instance, Website accessibility can mean:

- Browsing with text-to-speech or Braille displays (used by blind or visually impaired users).
- Customising the way a website displays to suit your needs (magnified text, different colour scheme etc.).
- Browsing without a mouse, with only the keyboard or a touch screen.

This can only be achieved if website design and updates comply with stringent standards.
